

PJMA Event Security

The volunteers who provide security for the PJMA events shall enforce and conduct themselves with the following PJMA performance standards, special conditions and actions

PJMA Performance Standards:

- a) No use of profane or obscene language.
- b) No use of profane or obscene gestures.
- c) No lewd or sexually explicit dancing on or off the stage.
- d) No use of words or descriptive acts that is profane, obscene, pornographic or violent in song lyrics performed or playing of CD's.
- e) No selling or give away of CD's, clothing, and or other materials which have word or descriptive acts that are profane, obscene, pornographic or violent.
- f) No wearing of clothing that advertises or suggests the use of profanity, obscene language, alcohol, tobacco, or illicit substances.
- g) No inciting directly or indirectly acts of violence, destruction or pornography.
- h) To remain with in the view of the event staff while at the event
- i) To remain fully clothed in attire appropriate to the event, at all times while at the event.
- j) Not to arrive to the event under the influences of any illicit substance such as alcohol or illegal drugs.
- k) Not to use alcohol, tobacco or illicit substances at the event.
- l) Not to promote through music, conversation, or clothing the use of tobacco, alcohol or illicit substances.
- m) No use of any satanic symbols.
- n) No hang out (loitering) in the parking lots or neighboring property
- o) Band members shall talk to their fans within the event area and not in the equipment staging area.
- p) No hitting other persons, running, moshing into persons, body surfing, stage diving, spitting of any liquids or throwing any items from the stage or in the audience at any time.
- q) Only band members and their stage support are allowed on the stage or in the band equipment staging area at any time.
- r) All facility items are to be returned to their proper place upon completion of the event and in the same working order as found.
- s) To refrain from excessive periods of affection between couples
- t) To sit on furniture designed seating and not on all others (i.e. pool tables, banquets tables, speakers, table games, etc)

Special Conditions

The following special conditions and terms apply for the security of PJMA events:

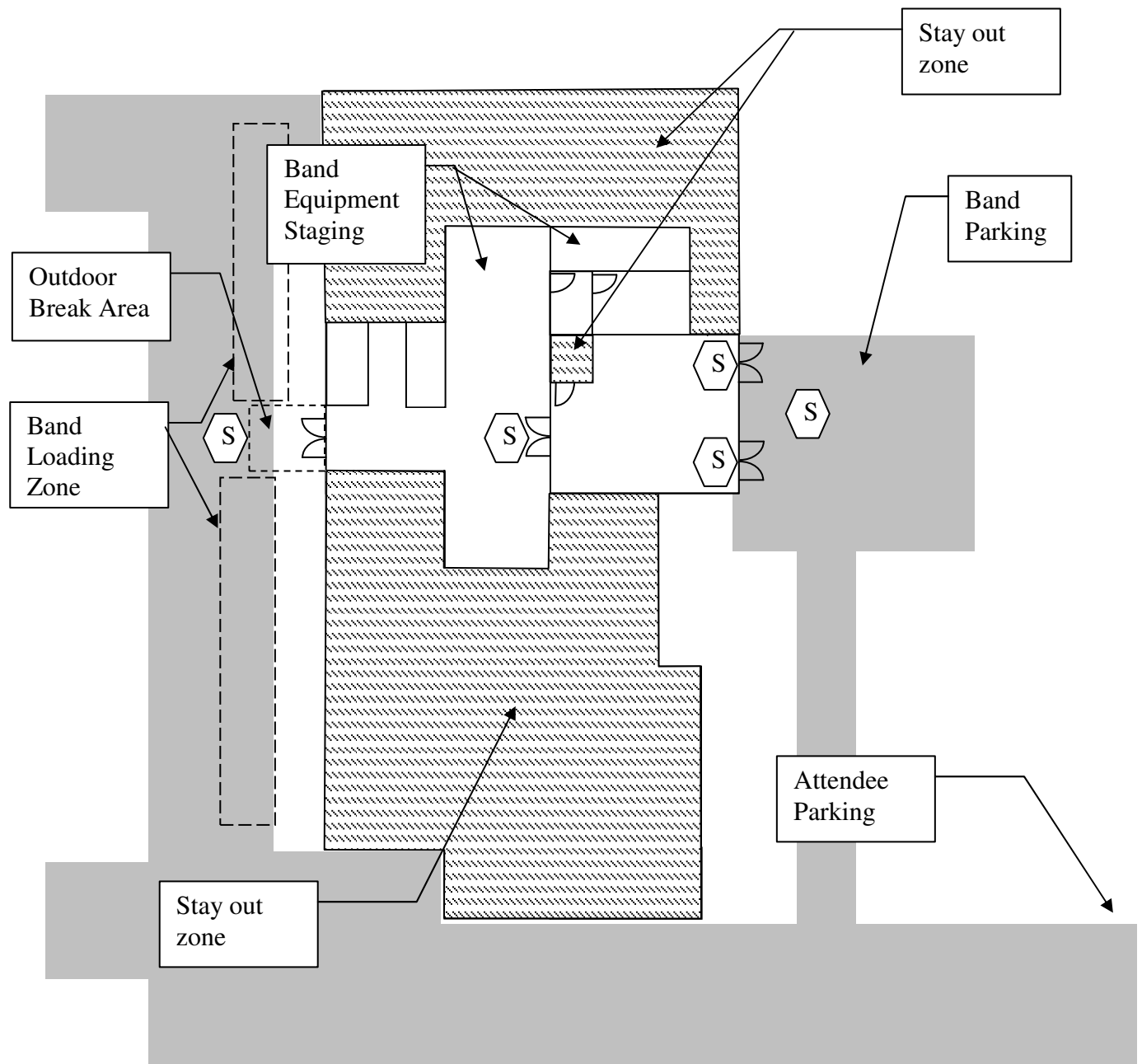
- a) All band guests are required to pay the door fee. There are no free guests.
- b) All paying attendees must continuously wear while attending the event an event wrist band or other unique event marking received after payment at the entrance.
- c) Parents and guardians are allowed into the event at no charge for the door fee, they shall be issued a free chaperon wrist band.
- d) The bands are allowed to have one stage support person, (unless contracted differently) to help setup, break down, and load vehicles.
- e) Only names on the PJMA Performance Contract are allowed to receive free event performer wrist bands. Additional loading support people who pay for attendee bands may be given event performer wrist bands to work for the band if named on the contract.(They will have two wrist bands).
- f) Attendees are not allowed in the band storage equipment areas. The band members and their support staff are.
- g) Security team members, facility staff and PJMA staff are allowed to receive free even staff wrist bands
- h) When audience members leave the facility for the night they are to remove their wrist bands and deposit them in the trash at the entrance. If they return later they must pay full price.
- i) No more than 8 event participants may congregate at outdoor areas designated for gathering, The use of the outdoor break area by an

- j) event participant is limited to 5 minutes, when there are other participants wanting to use the break area.
- j) Participants in the break area will not sit on the rails and will remain clear of the main exit/entrance walkway.
- k) Participants that going beyond the break area, or exit anywhere else from the facility will be considered leaving the event at the facility, they must surrender their wrist bands and they will have to pay to reenter.
- l) Event participants are not to congregate in ways that block the emergency exits. In the front entrance the participants may sit on the available seating or gather off the side of the hallways out of the main walkway.
- m) Band members are permitted to leave the facility only to access their vehicle to transport band equipment between their vehicles and the facility.
- n) Band members may carry their gear through other exits besides the main entrance only before the event opens or after the event is closed to the public. Otherwise the band members must use the main entrance.
- o) Audience and Band members are not permitted to bring food or drink into the event. All food and drink must be consumed in the vehicles and not on any of the outdoor property or neighboring property
- p) The event participants (band members, attendee, security team members, and PJMA staff) are to be financially responsible for PJMA property and or event facility property that they cause to be missing or damaged

Actions

The security team members shall take the following action for enforcement:

- a) Security staff shall use only verbal direction to event participants to enforce these standards and conditions.
- b) Physical and violent contact with event participants is to be avoided.
- c) The county sheriff deputy shall be used for enforcement of areas that are their legal responsibility.
- d) The security team has the discretion as to when an event participant should leave the event because the person excessively violated these standards and conditions. For most situations there should be at least 3 verbal warnings before considering the person must leave the event.
- e) The PJMA management and facility staff shall be notified of any event participant that is told to leave the event by a security team member.
- f) The security team members shall wear the PJMA Security T-shirt when providing security at a PJMA event. **(Please return security T-shirt to PJMA at end of event for cleaning and reuse at future events)**
- g) One member of the security team shall inspect the parking lot, building perimeter and nearby property every 15 minutes for compliance with these standards and conditions. i.e improper activities, no smoking, no loitering, no consumption of alcohol or illicit substances, etc.
- h) The hall/auditorium access/exit doors to the facility event area shall be monitored to prevent non-emergency use during the event and band access before and after the event.
- i) The PJMA management will designate one member of the security team shall be to be the security team lead. The lead will be the interface to the facility staff and the PJMA management. The lead will direct the other team members on where to provide security. The lead should be located in the hallway with visual contact of the front entrance and activities in the hall/auditorium
- j) The security team members shall comply with requests of the facility staff and county sheriff deputy for security and safety of the event at the facility

Security Team lead should be in the center of the building, the second security member should be working the entire outside from the front door, the third and fourth person works the doors to the auditorium, the Fifth security person will help the second security person with outside security from the rear of the building when available.
