



Arrival and Performance Info

Intro Six Flags America Balt/Wash (SFA) has contracted PJMA Inc to arrange for artist to perform on their Live and Local stages. The artists can be any type of entertainment provide it is family friendly, this includes but not limited to musical groups, dancers, speakers, magicians, marshal artist, etc. The arrangements allow artist to book performance through PJMA and start promoting immediate there after. The park has three stages for Live and Local performances. The Celebration Stage is located in the center of the park. Nearby is the second stage called the Beach Cove Stage and the third stage is located in the water park. Each stage has advantages and disadvantages. Please see the description of the stages for the details. Below is also lots of details from Booking to Performances to loading out.

Booking Process: Send an email to Booking@PJMA.info, asking for the dates and stage your group would like to perform at. You can also call or send a text message to 240-925-8659 to make initial contact. Once confirmed, you will be requested to provide the information on the Live and Local Artist Data Sheet and sign the PJMA/Six Flags Contract. After that you will get from SFA a preshow email that you will need to reply to confirm your performance.

Arrival Instructions: Please drive to the address given above for SFA Batl/Wash. When you enter drive to the right and enter the employee entrance. At the security gate identify yourself as coming to perform on the Live and Local Stage. The guard will allow those names provide on the Artist Data Sheet into the employee park lot. Next call the Point of Contact at Park for Live and Local and let her know you have arrived. To access the Park from the employee parking lot the name must have been on the Artist Data Sheet. All others must walk around to the attendee entrance of the park and show their ticket or purchase a ticket to enter. For those name on the Artist Data Sheet you will be allow to walk in by the employee entrance to the Celebration and Beach Cove Stage. It is possible to drive to the back of the Sunset Stage at the Water Park. All personnel and gear are subject to inspection prior to entering the park.

Unloading and Loading: Please plan to arrive at 9 AM if you want unload a vehicle at the stage. One vehicle will be allowed to drive into the park and next to the stage to unload. The vehicle must be able to leave the park and return to the employee parking Lot by 9:30. If you should need more than 30 minutes, then please make prior arrangements with Point of Contact at Park for Live and Local. To bring a vehicle back into the park to load out you will have to wait to after the park to closes, the times change depending upon the seasons. See the Hours of Operation given below for the closing times. The alternative to bring in a vehicle is to request the use of a cart that can shuttle gear between the employee parking and stage. SFA will not provide any personnel to assist with moving or setup of artist gear. All vehicle are subject to inspection prior to entering the park.



Performance Times: The SFA BALT/WAS requires each group concert to perform a minimum of 2 hours total. The ideal set is 30 minutes long and repeated 4 times throughout the day. Longer sets are possible; however audience attention is typically limited to 30 minutes. Music performances can be originals or covers. For PJMA sponsored multi band concerts, PJMA will determine the minimum times base on the number of bands participating in the concert.

Food and Drink: SFA BALT/WASH will allow Artist to bring into the park coolers that have food and drinks. All containers are subject to inspection prior to entering the park. Please store and consume your food and drinks in the private areas behind the stages. No alcoholic beverages are permitted in the park (see contract). Please clean up all waist and empty containers.

Artist Merchandise Sales: Artist are allowed to sell merchandise and keep all profits. All “merch” must be family friendly (see PJMA contract). SFA will provide a merch table and two chairs. The artist may want to bring a 10 by 10 popup tent. No stickers can be sold or given away (see contract). All merch sales or give aways must be within the immediate area of the assigned stage venue.

Artist Promoting at SFA. Artists are allowed to pass out flyers, business cards and band info, pictures, etc to promote the Artist and their activities/performances in the community. Please do not pass out sticker. The artist can solicit the attendees to join their email mail list by providing their emails. All promoting must be within the immediate area of the assigned stage venue. No posters or flyers can be posted or passed out anywhere else in the park. Band members can walk about the park speaking to people and inviting them to come to their performance

Artist Promoting SFA Performances. Artists that are booked by PJMA are allowed to pass out flyers the use the PJMA/SFA approved flyer. Artist that are booked by PJMA may also display on their websites their booking of SFA performances

Weather Cancelation SFA will cancel all performance on all stages if the weather is rain or other threatening in climate conditions. The stages are all outdoors with no overhead or side protection. If the park is open, but there is a chance of precipitation then the artist should plan to have means to cover up gear with tarps and or tents. There are no enclosed areas near the stages to provide protection from precipitation. Please call the Point of Contact at Park for Live and Local the day before your performance to determine if SFA is canceling performance on the stages due to weather.

Security: SFA has an extensive security staff with in the park. However, they are not dedicated to the Live and Local Stage area. All artist should take care to have their gear being secured thought the time they are in the park. During times when gear must remain on the stages, the cover the gear with a sheet and have someone like the merch table staff, watch the gear on the stage and storage area.

Compensation: SFA will provide free park access and free parking to all approve members of the artist group in the employee parking lot. There will be no other addition compensation.

Discount Tickets: For those who are not part of the artist group they can get discounted tickets. SFA has setup a special weblink for a half price tickets.

Stage Details

Celebration Stage

The Celebration Stage is located in the center of the park. It is setup with three levels, the center level is the highest and is big enough for a drum kit and one to two vocalist. The flanking side platforms are each about 15 feet long and 10 feet wide. Enough space for a guitar amps, guitar players and more singers. There is a roof over the center section, the flanking platforms have fake roof. There are speakers on the stage, but the PA is currently not working. Bands will need to bring their own sound system including amplifiers, speakers, sound board, microphones, mic cables and mic stands. A sound engineer is recommended to setup and operate the band provided sound system. It will be necessary to schedule the music program around a nearby 15 minute program in the open air theater (2:45 to 3:30 PM and 5:45 to 6:30. Out in front of the stage are folding chairs and across the walkway a smoking pavilion.

Directions: Drive or Walk in to the gate left of the employment building, Take the next right (along the train track so the right), bear to the left at the next intersection. The Celebration stage will be to right.

Beach Cove Stage

The Beach Cove stage is located about 100 feet from the Celebration Stage and is next to the Gotham City Areen. The stage is one large stage that is over 20 feet wide and 20 feet deep. There is no roof. There is electrical power but no PA system. Bands will need to bring their own sound system including amplifiers, speakers, sound board, microphones, mic cables and mic stands. A sound engineer is recommended to setup and operate the band provided sound system. Out in front are folding beach chairs on a sandy open area.

Directions: Drive or Walk in to the gate left of the employment building, Take the next right (along the train track so the right), bear to the right at the next intersection, drive forward to the stage on the right after the entrance to the Gotham Arena. The Beach Cove stage will be to right.

Sunset Stage

The Sunset stage is located on the west side of the Water Park. There is a road that vehicle can access the stage from the rear. The stage is over 30 feet wide and 20 feet deep. The stage is covered. The stage has a sound system, but is not available for band use. It will be used by SFA for a dance act that performs two times each day. Any band performance will have to work with the Dance team to provide a clear stage when they are required to perform. Bands will need to bring their own sound system including amplifiers, speakers, sound board, microphones, mic cables and mic stands. A sound engineer is recommended to setup and operate the band provided sound system. There is no formal seating out in front, however the stage does overlook all the beach lounge chairs for the waterpark.

Directions: Walk in to the gate left of the employment building, follow the signs to the water park, the stage will be at the opposite end of the park. If driving, then drive around the perimeter of the park to the back side of the stage just past the service area for the wave pool call the Point of Contact before driving to this location).
