Six Flags America Baltimore/Washington DC (SFA) is proud to introduce a fantastic promotional opportunity to developing artists called “Live & Local.” We are seeking upcoming bands and talented performers from around the world to perform at our park. The groups must be family friendly and perform a total of 2 hours that can be divided up into different or repeated sets. Our stages are in locations that see thousands of people passing by, creating a great opportunity to generate new fans and garner some merchandise sales! The park has two stages for Live & Local performances. The Celebration Stage is located in the center of the park and Sunset Stage, is located in the water park also known as Hurricane Harbor, by the wave pool. Check additional links on the home page for a description of the stages. We provide a pressure free performance and ensure Six Flags of fun!

Booking Process: Mail, email, or fax a completed application form to Jamie Ware, Special Event Supervisor. If approved, Jamie will email you with a confirmed date on which stage and a performance agreement that you will need to sign and fax to confirm the performance date and stage. No online outreach can be posted about performing at Six Flags America until signed agreement has been received and Six Flags America trademarks cannot be used without written approval. Arrival Instructions: Upon arrival call park contact and follow signs on the right to EMPLOYEE PARKING. The security guard will have the approved names from your Live & Local application. At the security gate identify yourself with photo identification and the officer will allow you to proceed. All personnel and gear are subject to inspection prior to entering and exiting the park.

1. If you are unloading equipment to **Celebration Stage**, continue straight ahead towards Human Resources, check in with 2nd security post and follow directional signs to EVENT BACKSTAGE to meet park contact to be escorted into the park.
2. Loading in at Sunset Stage, turn left at the two stop signs, turn right at the white booth, turn left at dead end, turn right at dead end onto exit road and take an immediate right turn into additional parking. You will see to your right a green fence. Look for the open gate or gate with a #7.
3. If you are not unloading, turn left at the two stop signs and park in the main parking lot, **DO NOT** park in Bugs Bunny lots. After parking in the main parking lot, check in at GUEST RELATIONS to the right of the main gate to receive access into the park. Names not approved on the application must enter through the toll plaza and main entrance of the park with a purchased

Load In/Out: Sunset Stage has an access road directly behind the stage for convenient load in and out at anytime for 2 vehicles. **Celebration Stage** load in is at 9 AM. No more than 2 vehicles will be allowed to drive into the park and unload next to the stage. The vehicles must leave the park and return to the main parking lot by 10 AM. Load in after 9 AM can request a cart to transport gear between the nearest backstage access road and stage, about 300 feet distance. SFA does not provide assistance moving or setting up equipment. Vehicles can access **Celebration Stage** for load out once the park is clear of guests, approx. 1 hour after park closes. Unfortunately we do not have lights at Live & Local stages for evening performances or late load outs. To load out before park closes you can cart equipment 300 feet to the nearest backstage access road. SFA can provide a cart.

Performance Times: SFA requires each group to perform a minimum of 2 hours total. The ideal set is 30 minutes long and repeated 4 times throughout the day. Music performances can be originals or covers. Set times are to be determined by Artist and SFA to avoid conflict with other SFA entertainment. Live & Local performance time minimum may be shortened based on other SFA entertainment schedules.

Food and Drink: SFA will allow Artist to bring into the park coolers that have food and non alcoholic drinks since food and water is not provided. All containers are subject to inspection prior to entering and exiting the park. Please consume your food and drinks in backstage areas. No alcoholic beverages are permitted in the park. Please clean up all waste and empty containers. Artists do have access to discounted employee canteen but must be escorted by SFA supervisor.

Artist Merchandise Sales: Artists are encouraged to sell merchandise at the stage only and receive 100% profits. All merchandise must be family friendly and approved by SFA prior to selling. SFA will provide a table. No stickers can be sold or given away. No tips or donations are to be solicited.

Artist Promoting at SFA: Artists are encouraged to pass out family-friendly promotional materials in stage zoning area only (10 ft. surrounding the stage) and must be approved by SFA prior to distributing. Please do not pass out stickers or information that does not promote the Artist.

Artist Promoting SFA Performances: Artists are encouraged to post their SFA performance date(s) on their ARTIST website only. Email the Live & Local contact to request additional online marketing or permission to produce promotional materials before posting or printing; please attach proofs for written approval. SFA logos, names and likeness cannot be used without written approval.

Security: SFA has an extensive security staff in the park. However, they are not dedicated to the Live & Local Stage areas. All artists should take care of their gear being secured throughout the time they are in the park. During times when gear must remain on the stages, artists should cover the gear or have someone like the merch table staff, watch the gear on the stage and backstage area. There is no secure backstage area at either stage, they are all open/outdoor venues with no cover. Tarps are encouraged.

Compensation: SFA will provide free park admission and parking to approved band and crew members (all performers and 4 crew members) on the day of the performance. There is no compensation.

Discount Tickets: SFA will send Artist a Live & Local ticket discount link to forward to friends, family and fans once their signed performance agreement has been received. Do not post discount, forward link.

Weather Cancellation: Artist is allowed to cancel appearance due to weather. SFA will only cancel performance if the park is closed. The stages are all outdoors with no over head or side protection. If the park is open, but there is a chance of precipitation then the artist should plan to cover up gear with personal tarps or tents. There are no enclosed areas near the stages to provide protection from precipitation.
